Make connections that could help bring a missing person home

If you or someone you know have been impacted by the mysterious disappearance of a loved one, plan to attend **Missing in Harris County Day** to make connections with local law enforcement and social service agencies dedicated to finding missing persons.

What to expect at Missing in Harris County Day:

- Personal guides to help navigate you through the Missing Persons reporting process
- Private area for family and friends to talk with Missing Persons professionals, file a report and provide other documentation
- Forensic professionals performing cheek swabs to collect DNA from family members for entry into the national Missing Persons database
- CyberSecurity demonstrations and pointers for protecting yourself and your child online
- Panel discussion with representatives from Texas EquuSearch, National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, HPD and HCSO Missing Persons officers and other missing persons experts
- Electronic fingerprinting of children and take-home child ID kits
- Public area with booths and a play area for children

Bring the following if you are searching for a missing loved one:

- Your photo ID
- Photos of the missing person helpful photos will include the person photographed with any identifying features, such as tattoos or birthmarks, or personal items, such as favorite earrings
- Two of the missing person's closely related family members from the mother's side for the collection of DNA
- X-rays, dental or medical records, police reports or other identifying documents that can be scanned and placed on file
- Families and friends are welcome to wear memorial t-shirts, bring posters or any literature to display and commemorate their missing loved one (any literature or photos left behind will not be returned)

Registration is encouraged, but not required.
